Obama's War on [of] Terror May Resemble Bush's in Some Areas Even as it pulls back from harsh interrogations and other sharply debated aspects of George W. Bush's "war on terrorism," the Obama administration is quietly signaling continued support for other major elements of its predecessor's approach to fighting 'Al Qaeda.' In little-noticed confirmation testimony, Obama nominees endorsed **continuing the C.I.A.'s program of transferring prisoners to other countries without legal rights, and indefinitely detaining terrorism suspects without trials** even if they were arrested far from a war zone. The administration has also embraced the Bush legal team's arguments that a lawsuit by former C.I.A. detainees should be shut down based on the "state secrets" doctrine. It has also left the door open to resuming military tribunal 'trials.'

Cases --Will Obama institute a new kind of preventive detention for terrorist suspects? By Jane Mayer Unless the Obama Administration overhauls the nation's terrorism policies, [Ali Saleh Kahlah al-] Marri--who claims that he is innocent--will likely spend the rest of his life in prison... Interviewed just before the Inauguration, he [John Ashcroft, who was Attorney General when Marri was designated an enemy combatant] defended what he described as a "sound decision" to "maximize the national interest," and predicted that, in the end, President Obama's approach to handling terror suspects would closely mirror his own: "How will he be different? The main difference is going to be that he spells his name 'O-b-a-m-a,' not 'B-u-s-h.'"

MI5 fed questions to CIA for interrogation -Agency refused to say how or where prisoner held MI5 provided the CIA with material to interrogate Binyam Mohamed, the former UK resident at the centre of torture allegations, even though it had no idea where he was being held and in what condition he was in, it emerged. Fresh evidence surrounding Mohamed's detention before he was flown to Guantánamo Bay shows the CIA rejected MI5's request to see him.

Is Israel assassinating Iran nuclear scientists?

Recent deaths of important figures in procurement and enrichment process in Iran and Europe have been the result of Israeli "hits." 17 Feb 2009 Israel is assassinating Iranian nuclear scientists as part of a covert war against the Islamic Republic's [alleged] illicit weapons program, the Daily Telegraph on Tuesday quoted Western intelligence analysts as saying. The British daily said Israel's Mossad espionage agency was rumored to be behind the death of Ardeshire Hassanpour, a top nuclear scientist at Iran's Isfahan uranium plant, who died in mysterious circumstances from reported "gas poisoning" in 2007.

'I was victim of medieval torture,' says freed Guantanamo detainee --Return of British resident after seven years fuels demands for Government to clarify role of MI5 agents 24 Feb 2009 The seven-year ordeal of a British resident who claims he was brutally tortured before being sent to Guantanamo Bay was brought to an end last night during an emotional reunion with his family. Last night Mr Mohamed's release from US custody reignited calls for the British Government to publish secret documents that would shine further light on the involvement of MI5 agents in his interrogation and alleged torture.

Binyam Mohamed back in UK, claiming 'torturers' linked to British agents 23 Feb 2009 Guantanamo Bay prisoner Binyam Mohamed has arrived back in the UK, claiming that his "torturers" were receiving questions and material from British intelligence agents. Former prisoner Mr Mohamed alleges that he was tortured into falsely confessing to terrorist activities and claims MI5 officers were complicit in his abuse.

Terror Convictions Overturned in France 25 Feb 2009 A French appeals court on Tuesday overturned terrorist conspiracy

convictions for five former inmates of the Guantánamo Bay prison camp who had been tried and convicted in 2007, after they were returned to France. The court ruled that information gathered by French intelligence officials in interrogations at Guantánamo Bay violated French rules for permissible evidence, and that there was no other proof of wrongdoing.
