

British Bobbies To Be Microchipped as Robocops

As a former Metropolitan Police Officer, it was with great concern that I read yesterday's announcement by Sir Ian Blair, The Police Commissioner of London, that every one of the 31,000 serving officers will be 'Microchipped' so that their 'movements' can be monitored more effectively. The new device called the 'Automated Personal Location System' or APLS will mean that Officers will 'never' be out of range of supervisors. This massive invasion of the 'last frontier' of human privacy (a person's self) is being sold as a means by which better protection can be afforded patrol units. What nobody, including the Police Federation seems to understand, is that once 'embedded' into a person, the potential of this 'chip' goes much further than merely being used as a tracking device.

The 'Personal Microchip' is the Illuminati's 'icing on the cake' where social control is concerned, and the key to the global control of the planet's population. If this 'mandatory' chipping of London Police Officers goes ahead, the precedent will be set, and how long will it be before the 'Armed Forces', and other 'Emergency Services' follow suit? Connie Fogal, Leader, Canadian Action Party / Parti action canadienne (CAP / PAC), who cannot be present at the April 21, 2008 press conference at the New Orleans Marriott Hotel in New Orleans, Louisiana due to financial constraints, sends her personal support and the support of CAP / PAC to the Coalition to Block the North American Union, (NAU), and stands with them in total opposition to the integration of North America.

Ms. Fogal urges Canada's NDP International Trade Critic Peter Julian (Burnaby-New Westminster), U.S.

Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur (Democrat, Ohio), and the Honourable Yeidekol Polevsky (senator for Mexico State and vice-president of the Mexican Senate) to join forces with the USA based Coalition to Block the North American Union AND to use their elected status in leadership to begin the DISMANTLING of the NAU and return each country to its SOVEREIGN NATION status.

Connie Fogal insists that it is far too little that M.P. Peter Julian, Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur, and the Honourable Yeidekol Polevsky have agreed to work "to stop further implementation of the so-called Security and Prosperity Partnership (SPP) process, imposed undemocratically on our three nations, and to open up the process that has taken place behind closed doors to instead have a transparent review and scrutiny within their respective legislatures." Fogal further explains, "The efforts of these good people to call for a halt at the current level of integration with 'transparency', 'review', and 'scrutiny', instead of immediate TERMINATION and REVERSAL of the integration process shows how constrained are our legislators to act in our interest, and how far behind they are from the will of the informed electorate".

Connie Fogal, who was a leading opponent of the expansion of gambling in Canada, often quoted a witness from the gambling industry as reported by Professor Robert Goodman in his classic 1984 Ford Foundation study about the impact of the use of gambling as a means of running the economy of a nation. **That witness said of legislators who supported gambling to rev the economy of a nation that they were unwitting fools and willing dupes of the gambling industry.**

Fogal considers that legislators Julian, Kaptur, and Polevsky appear to be encouraging the rest of us to live with the current level of integration, but with "transparency", "review" and "scrutiny" of the integration process.

"If so," Fogal says, "they are 'unwitting fools', 'willing dupes', and facilitators for the financial/corporate / military rule at hand."

Canadian NDP Trade Critic, Peter Julian (Burnaby-New Westminster), U.S. Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur (D-Ohio), the Honourable Yeidekol Polevsky (Senator for Mexico State and Vice-president of the Mexican Sen-

ate), and the Honourable Victor Quintana (Deputy of the State of Chihuahua, Mexico), with support from their respective political parties say they have launched a Task Force on Renegotiating NAFTA, to promote within their respective legislatures the renegotiation of the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) to achieve a fair trade policy.

Connie Fogal says this is deception of the people. "NAFTA never was and never will be about trade. It always was and can only remain the Trojan Horse to bring about the unification of North America. Pregnant woman 'never calling the police again'

19-year-old, who faces no charges, distressed at being behind bars after attempts to subpoena her as witness in domestic assault case failed Apr 08, 2008 04:30 AM Michele Henry Crime Reporter

Noellee Mowatt has vowed never to call police again — in any situation, even if she's suffering.

Through choking sobs yesterday morning, Mowatt, 19, made the pact from a pay phone at a Milton jail, where she's spending the last few days of her pregnancy.

Due to deliver, the teenager has been detained at Vanier Centre for Women since when a justice of the peace denied her bail.

Mowatt, who faces no criminal charges in this case, won't be let out until she testifies at her boyfriend's domestic assault trial on Friday.

"I only made a mistake by calling the cops," she said.

"This is what I get. ... I'm never calling the police again — even if I'm dying, I'm not going to call them."

Mowatt, is worried that the stress of being in prison will affect the health of her baby, a girl, and is struggling to understand why she's being "punished."

She called police in December to report that her boyfriend Christopher Harbin, 25, had assaulted her.

Harbin is facing eight charges: four counts of assault, including assault with a weapon, forcible confinement and three counts of breaching probation.

Toronto police said they tried several times to serve the expectant mother with a

subpoena to show up in court. When she wasn't present March 20, a judge issued a material warrant for her arrest.

According to Mowatt's defence lawyer Lydia Riva, a judge can issue such a warrant if there is evidence someone won't respond to a subpoena or is evading a subpoena.

Mowatt, who lived in shelters and a rooming house before her arrest April 1, said that while she had several conversations with detectives, no one ever asked her to pick up a subpoena or tried to drop one off.

"They're treating me like I'm a murderer," she said. "I didn't kill anybody. I didn't do anything wrong."

Sheamus Murphy, spokesperson for Ontario's Attorney General Chris Bentley, said that he can't comment on the case because it is before the courts, but he did say the facts in this matter have been reviewed by two independent judicial officers — the judge who issued the warrant and the justice of the peace who denied Mowatt bail.

Murphy added that even though it is the job of police to collect evidence, and protecting the victim is always a first priority, "they can't always avoid having the complainant testify."

Mowatt's incarceration has created a stir within the women's advocacy community in Toronto.

Several groups said yesterday they can't remember the last time a victim of domestic violence was held in jail on a material warrant.

However, it is not the first time, Murphy confirmed.

Amanda Dale of the YWCA is baffled that such means, which are usually employed to compel other criminals to testify, would be used on someone so vulnerable.

She's worried about the precedent set by Mowatt's jail time.

"It's counterproductive to the broader goal of getting women to leave violent situations," she said.

"It will have a chilling effect on anyone coming forward and reporting to the police."

Riva said her client was denied bail last Thursday, despite offers of paying Mowatt under house arrest, having her report daily to police and promising to appear in court for Harbin's trial.

Mowatt, who immigrated to Canada in 2006 to live with her father, who died last summer, said she sends money, when she has it, back to Jamaica, where her 2-year-old daughter lives with Mowatt's mother.

Mowatt said she's worried about being in jail with women who have hepatitis and HIV.

She's also anxious about testifying at her boyfriend's trial. Harbin supported her, she said, and the two plan to take correspondence courses, raise a family and marry.

She regrets calling the police in December after she and Harbin had an argument and he was "kicking her out."

"He's my best friend," she said. "He's a good person. He's a good man. And now they want me to testify. I'm going to be way too emotional to say anything."

Introductory Comment by Connie Fogal, leader, CAP/PAC

The REAL ID practice is coming to birth in various Canadian provinces as a result of federal and provincial commitment to a North American integration under provincial buy in to the 2001 Smart Border Declaration and the 2005 Security and Prosperity Partnership Agreement. April 2, 2008 6:52 PM PDT Homeland Security blinks on Real ID: No hassles on May 11 WASHINGTON—In the long-running Real ID staring match, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security ended up being the first to blink.

Homeland Security announced Wednesday that all 50 states and the District of Columbia will be technically Real ID-compliant by the May 11, 2008 deadline—even though many states actually have rejected the concept and have zero plans to embrace a national ID card.

This means Americans will face no new hassles when using their drivers licenses to enter federal buildings or fly on airplanes starting on May 11. That's a good thing.

But the way this turned out is so odd it's worth repeating. States including New Hampshire, Maine, South Carolina, Oklahoma, Washington, and Montana have enacted laws saying "hell no we'll never comply with Real ID." And Homeland Security officials carefully ignored those public votes of condemnation, instead pretending that those states really intend to acquiesce by the next major deadline of December 31, 2009. (See our special report on Real ID from earlier this year.)

"Now they've got 18 months to actually finish the process of being able to issue the cards that will meet the requirements," Homeland Security Secretary Michael Chertoff told a small group of reporters and bloggers here on Wednesday. "We will have to watch this because the one thing that will be important is for a state not to be dilatory in completing the process."

That may have been a more serious threat a few years ago, when Chertoff was beginning his defense of the Real ID Act, which became law as part of a must-pass tsunami relief and Iraq emergency appropriations bill in 2005.

Now, however, state officials realize that Homeland Security is more likely to back down than not. The first sign of

this came when the agency decided to treat a request for an extension past May 11 as a formal agreement to comply with all Real ID rules. The second came when Homeland Security retreated to its fallback position: even a symbolic gesture on the part of a governor amounted to full compliance.

A good example of this dynamic is what happened in the last few days involving Maine, a state that has rejected Real ID in no uncertain terms, and was the only will-have-trouble-at-airports state as of this morning. Its legislation approved last year says that it "refuses to implement the Real ID Act and thereby protest the treatment by Congress and the president of the states as agents of the federal government."

Maine nevertheless asked the feds not to penalize its travelers. Stewart Baker, Homeland Security assistant secretary for policy, replied in a letter that if Maine "is prepared to commit" to embracing Real ID by 5 p.m. on April 2, "we will grant an extension conditioned upon performance of these commitments."

(The commitments Baker requested include using a Homeland Security identity verification system, using facial recognition technology so someone can't get two licenses, and so on.)

In response, Gov. John Baldacci, a Democrat, wrote back to Baker saying in part:

I will seek legislation to halt Maine's current practice of issuing licenses to those not present lawfully in the United States.

I will submit legislation, which includes a funding source and appropriations, that will adopt three changes in Maine's licensing processes:

Maine will enter into an agreement with USCIS and utilize the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements Program to verify DHS documents presented by non-citizens.

Maine will begin capturing and maintaining photographs of each individual applying for a license or state identification card, even if no license is issued.

It worked. Maine got a green check mark, and its licenses will continue to be valid for federal purposes after May 11—even though Baldacci was, for the most part, merely promising to introduce legislation. And the Maine legislators, who soundly rebuked the Bush administration by nearly unanimous votes last year, will be the ones to vote on it.

Last month, Montana took a similar approach. Its governor, Brian Schweitzer, a Democrat, has repeatedly denounced Real ID and even called on his counterparts (PDF) in other states to oppose it. But Homeland Security dutifully accepted a relatively hostile letter from Schweitzer—saying he will never "authorize implementation of the Real ID Act"—as good enough.

Now that the May 11 deadline has become effectively meaningless, the next major deadline is December 31, 2009, at which point Homeland Security currently says it will require "certification that the state has achieved the benchmarks set forth in the Material Compliance Checklist."

In political terms, that's a long time—and a new presidential administration—away. Some opponents of Real ID are already predicting that no state will actually comply with the deadline, or, alternatively, the next administration will find a way to quietly dispose of Real ID without much fanfare.

"DHS is not in power here," said Jim Harper, the director of information policy studies at the free-market Cato Institute. "The states are in power. DHS has done all it could, but from a position of weakness...DHS put the best face it could on its capitulation to states with backbone. A lot more states will recognize that they own this issue, they control this debate."
